PORTRAIT OF LÄNDLE

The heart of Vorarlberg, the western most state of Austria, is concentrated around the Rhine and Walgau valleys. Here from north to south are not only the largest cities Bregenz (state capital), Dornbirn, Feldkirch and Bludenz but also a Europe-wide leading vibrant economical and cultural region.

Surrounded Munich beautiful mountainous region of Montafon, Arlberg and the Bregenzerwald and the charming and dynamic Lake Constance triangle border, Vorarlberg offers the unique combination of urban lifestyle and natural serenity.

The attractive geographic location of Vorarlberg is greatly appreciated. The state, lovingly nicknamed 'Ländle' by its inhabitants borders the three highly developed countries of Germany, Switzerland and Liechtenstein and offers excellent leisure activities and employment opportunities through the cultural and economical diversity. Cities such as St. Gallen (Switzerland), Vaduz (Liechtenstein) or Lindau (Germany) are easily accessible by public transportation as well as by car.

The comprehensive leisure program in Vorarlberg offers everything your heart desires. With its diversified landscapes of the mountains, the Rhine Valley and Lake Constance, you can enjoy almost any recreational activity you can imagine.

Vorarlberg also attracts many sports enthusiasts to the country every year. Numerous ski resorts which lie over 1,000 metres above sea level offer the perfect conditions for snowy slopes. There are also winter hiking trails, cross-country skiing trails and toboggan runs to ensure there is something for everyone - whether in the Arlberg region or in Bregenzerwald, Kleinwalsertal, Großes Walsertal or Montafon.

From spring to autumn you can hike, bike, swim, golf, do alpine trendsports and much more.

Lake Constance offers a wealth of opportunities: there are many sailing clubs, surfing and kitesurfing are possible when the wind is good and diving in Lake Constance is yet another appealing option.

In addition to the cycling paths along the streets, cyclists have access to a national and local cycle path network of approximately 300 km.

Golf is experiencing a boom. The alpine scenery offers a beautiful backdrop for the state's six golf courses.

In all seasons, the state offers a wide variety of wellness options. There are numerous excellent health, wellness and spa facilities throughout the state.

Above all there is the Bregenz Festival on Lake Constance. The world's largest lake stage shines with opera and musical productions which receive rave reviews again and again. The newly built area of the Bregenz Festival Hall offers theatre, concerts, musicals, ballets and shows throughout the whole year.

The Schubert Festivals in Schwarzenberg and Hohenems became the most important and renowned Schubert Festivals worldwide. The ‚Zwischentöne‘ festival in Feldkirch has become a multi-faceted festival that offers a range of different musical delights.

The largest theatre in the state is the Landestheater in Bregenz. Vorarlberg, in relation to its size, has a large and active theatre scene. Besides that numerous small cultural events offer something for everyone.

In terms of contemporary art, the KUB - Kunsthaus Bregenz (Bregenz Art Museum) offers one of the best exhibition programs in Europe. The Vorarlberger Landesmuseum (VLM) (Vorarlberg Museum) presents the history and culture of the state.

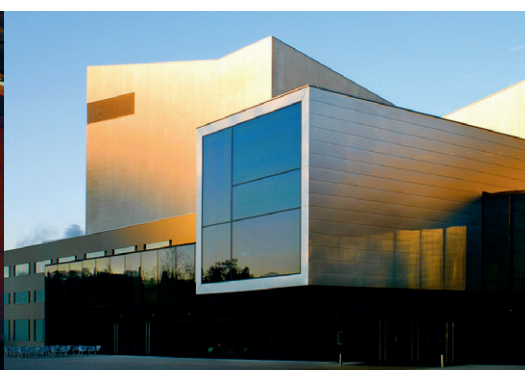

Good eating and drinking are standard in Vorarlberg. With the highest density of gourmet restaurants in Austria and an above average number of dedicated family-run restaurants and comfortable traditional inns at a high-quality level, Vorarlberg has the potential to become a European gourmet region.

The weekly farmers' markets in the city pedestrian zones in many communities are highly valued.

'Riebel' with apple sauce

(for approx. 2 – 4 portions)

- 300 g corn semolina
- 300 ml milk
- 200 ml water
- ½ teaspoon salt
- 30 g butter

- 1 Bring the milk, water and butter to a boil in a saucepan. Then reduce the heat and stir in the corn semolina until the mixture thickens.
- 2 Leave covered (ideally overnight).
- 3 Cut out pieces and fry in a large frying pan with butter until golden brown while constantly turning over (reduce the heat before it burns).
- 4 Can be served cold or hot. Sprinkle with icing sugar before serving — apple sauce goes well with it.
